

POLICY FOR DNA BANK MATERIAL TRANSFER

The material housed in the Garden's DNA Bank has been collected to support studies of plant and fungal diversity, and of the evolutionary mechanisms underlying diversity. External requests for material for such research projects will be considered; material will not be provided for any commercial application, including gene screening for bioprospecting, or agricultural applications. Requests for material should be addressed to Dr. Lisa M. Campbell, Administrative Curator, Plant Research Laboratory, The New York Botanical Garden, Bronx, NY 10458 U.S.A., (lcampbell@nybg.org), and include the following:

1. A description of the project, including the names of collaborators.
2. Taxa desired and amount of tissue or genomic DNA required.
3. A signed copy of the Material Transfer Agreement.
